**DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN  
UNCONTESTED APPLICATION**

**Authority:**

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

**Summary of Evidence**

The complete file has been made available to me.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant has demonstrated a good knowledge of the Sale and Supply of alcohol Act and is suitable to hold a manager's certificate.

A report from the Police has no objection to the application.

**Evaluation of Evidence**

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter can, therefore, be dealt with on the papers. The applicant is employed at The Cook Saddle Café and Saloon at Fox Glacier where she is one of the business owners. I understand that the applicant is not regularly a rostered manager on duty and she is at the premises most days and covers for others as required. Ms. Scott has previously held a General Manager's Certificate and let it lapse.

The applicant has been part of the hospitality industry for 20 Years. The application is accompanied by two references the contents of which give a very clear message that the applicant is capable and able to undertake the role of a manager in the hospitality industry. I have no concerns as to the suitability of this applicant.

I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, she does not have any convictions recorded against her, she has experience within the industry and she holds a recognised qualification

**Decision and Reasons**

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.222 of the Act.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number 012-2022 and I direct that a certificate be issued to Deborah Clare Scott pursuant to s.64 of the Act for a period of 12 months.
